
Attaching the Chair Legs

- Place the right leg (A), left leg (B), and connecting tube (C) on a soft, clean and level surface.
- Attach the connecting tube (C) to the right leg (A) and left leg (B) using M6 \times 20 mm bolts (AA), small washers (DD), and hex wrench (GG).
- Do not overtighten the bolts.




Attaching the Chair Seat and Back


Attaching the Loveseat Legs

- Place the right leg (A), left leg (B), and support tube
 (F) on a soft, clean and level surface.
- $_{\Box}$ Attach the support tube (F) to the chair right leg (A) and left leg (B) by using M6 x 20 mm bolts (AA), small washer (DD), and hex wrench (GG)
- Do not overtighten the bolts.



2 Attaching the Loveseat Seat and Back

- Place the loveseat seat (G) and back (H) on a soft, clean and level surface.
- Attach the back (H) to the seat (G), by using hex wrench (GG), $M6 \times 35$ mm bolts (BB), small washers (DD), screw nut-M6 (FF), and wrench (HH).




3 Attaching the Legs

- Insert the finsihed loveset seat and back from step 2 into the leg frames on step 1.
- Attach the back (H) and seat (G) to the legs (A & B),
 by using M8 x 35 mm bolts (CC), larger washers (EB),
 and larger hex wrench (II)
- Fully tighten all the bolts on this loveseat.



Placing the Cushion

- Place the seat cushion (I) and back cushion (J) on the loveseat seat (G) and loveseat back (H).
- The loveseat is now ready for use.



Maintenance

- When cleaning the cushions, use a mild soap and water mixture (D0 NOT USE BLEACH) and gently rub the surface of the fabric and rinse with
 water. Allow time for cushions to dry before use. Always cover your cushions with waterproof covers when you are not using it to prolong the
 life of the cushions.
- Always make certain to cover your outdoor wood furniture with waterproof covers when you are not using it. Using covers will protect your furniture from all-weather elements and prolong the life of the wood furniture. Do not use plastic covers to protect your furniture as this may cause mold to grow on your furniture.

Care and Cleaning

Follow these care and maintenance instructions to ensure your outdoor furniture lasts for years to come.

FRAME CARE

- Use mild soap and warm water to clean the frames.
- Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly. Be sure to drain any water accumulated inside the frames, To thoroughly drain frames, remove footcaps and tilt frames, if necessary, to remove all water. Water allowed to accumulate inside the frames and then exposed to sub-freezing temperatures can cause damage to frame tubing. Such damage caused by conditions other than normal is not covered under warranty.
- Any rust spots should be lightly sanded and treated with rust inhibitor and followed with an application of touch-up paint (not included).

CUSHION CARE

- Dust fabric weekly and remove dirt before it becomes embedded.
- For cleaning, use a mild cleaner with warm water. Rinse thoroughly. Filp cushions on their sides with the zipper facing down and unzipped to ensure that all water drains.
- Avoid standing water on the surface of cushions.
- Cushions should be stored in a dry place if possible.
